TEAM CHRIS COMBS ANNOUNCES SECOND ANNUAL HOPE GALA TO DEFEAT ALS Proceeds To Fund Critical Project ALS Research

Following a year of unprecedented ALS research and fundraising, Team Chris Combs will hold its second annual *Hope Gala to Defeat ALS* on Friday, September 29, 2017 at the Umstead Hotel in Cary, NC. Last year's inaugural Hope Gala raised \$1 million, and was the largest fundraising event in the history of the acclaimed venue. Proceeds raised at the first event were directed to the immediate expansion of the Project ALS Pre-Clinical Core at Columbia University's Motor Neuron Center. This year's gala predicts even larger success, and is crucial to next efforts to build upon this aggressive drug-testing initiative.

Led by Chris Combs and his wife, Gena, Team Chris Combs decided to partner with Project ALS when Chris, father of three, and former first baseman and pitcher for the North Carolina State Wolfpack and Pittsburgh Pirates, was diagnosed with ALS in 2016.

"We are so thankful to have met the amazing Project ALS team and are forever grateful for everything they are doing to advance treatments for a world without ALS," said Gena Combs. "They have given us support, guidance and hope during this ALS journey."

Directed by Drs. Serge Przedborski and Hynek Wichterle, the Project ALS Pre-Clinical Core – the first of its kind–systematically screens potential therapies in a wide range of ALS models under one roof, before delivering the most promising of them to human trial. The facility collaborates multiple laboratories, research institutions, and pharmaceutical companies. The overall goal: a thorough, responsible, fast-track selection process of FDA approved drugs for their potential efficacy in ALS. Additionally, the Project ALS Pre-Clinical Core is poised to pursue longer term efforts utilizing in-house chemistry to maximize the potential of helpful molecules and promising compounds.

"Chris Combs and his wife Gena are leading an unparalleled charge in the fight against ALS," said Valerie Estess, Project ALS director of research. "Their laser focus on bringing promising therapeutic targets to the clinic as fast as possible is accelerating the pace of ALS drug discovery. The Core is already interrogating four new drug candidates. We aim to get answers for patients faster."

ALS is a brain disease that is closely related to Parkinson's, Alzheimer's, and Huntington's. Also known as Lou Gehrig's disease, ALS targets brain cells called motor neurons. Motor neurons send messages from the brain to muscles throughout the body. In ALS, as motor neurons weaken and die, a person progressively loses the ability to walk, speak, swallow, and breathe. ALS affects adults of all ages, from teens to seniors.
